Description of Project:

COPA will work *with* Houston Arboretum staff on a conservation project on the Arboretum grounds. Your volunteers will assist with the removal of understory plant species on our trails and grounds. Your team of volunteers will use loppers to remove these plants in an area selected by our conservation crew.
